

With reference to your letter of the 23rd instant, in which you ask that a seed drill be purchased "for the Colony Farm Instructor's use" at your Agency, I have to request that you will furnish full information as to why the seed drill is required. Does the Instructor at the Colony put in a crop for the Department? Is the implement required for the Indians belonging to the Colony? I may say that it is considered that the Indians should supply such implements for themselves.
