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(b) Convoys -

On the 31st August and 1st September, respectively, the Bermuda (12), the Halifax (19) and the Sydney (11) Sections of a convoy left their assembly ports to effect sections of a convoy left their assembly ports to effect junction at sea. The Bermuda Section, until junction with the Halifax Section, was under the escort of H.M.S. "EMERALD". The combined convoy sailed under the ocean escort of H.M.S. "MONTCLARE".
