- (h) In the event of conviction of any individual or organization of an international offence, then all nations shall be allowed to confiscate all assets owned or controlled, either directly or indirectly, by such convicted individual or organization, etc., in such nation's territories, colonies or protectorates.
- (1) In the event of conviction of any company, individual, etc., the convicted party or parties shall never again be allowed to re-organize, under a new name or in a new company, in any part of the world. Neither the officials nor shareholders shall be allowed to hold any interests or positions, either directly or indirectly, in any other company or organization, at any time, in any part of the world. They are expelled from any form of activity and at no time shall any such persons be accepted as a responsible party in any part of the world. Having broken the laws of the

International Court, which represents all people, they have committed an offence against every living person and therefore have rendered themselves outcasts in any of the world's business. NOTE

This prevents the re-formation of illegal organizations in any part of the world by such organizations and/or individuals as have been convicted by the International Court of transgressions against international law. This means that any person
