Note - The region is largely drift covered but the eastern part is believed to be almost entirely underlain by Laurentian rocks and the western part by Keewatin rocks. The small mineral areas on the western portion of the sheet indicate observed outcrops of Laurentian and Keewatin protruding through the drift.
