WALLACETOWN.

Is an important post village in the Township of Dunwich, situated on the Talbot Street or Stage Road from St. Thomas to Chatham. Distant from the former place 20 miles; 47 miles from the latter, and 3 miles from Tyrconnell a shipping port on Lake Erie.

FOUNDER.—A. McBrayne's Agricultural Implement Manufactory is a desideratum much needed in this section of the country.

CARRIAGE WORKS.—Duncan McLaws, employs 6 to 8 hands, and turns out carriages, waggons, buggies, sleighs and cutters.
