BOARD OF HEALTH .- An Act was passed at the last Session of the Legislature for establishing a Board of Health in this City and County only. This act provides, that any Board of Health which might be in existence in this City and County on the 30th of April, should be continued in force under the new act, which came into operation on the 1st day of May. Yesterday, the members of the old Board met at the Mayor's Office, and re-organised under the new act ; -after which an entirely new set of regulations for the preservation of the public health and provention of nuisances in this City, and in the Parish of Portland, were passed by the Board, as also amended regulations for Quarautine, which will be published forthwith.

Among other regulations it was ordered that no building whatever should be used as a Slaughter-house in this City, or in the Parish of Portland, after the first day of June Best, without permission in writing from the Board.
