be collected in each and every District of this Province be appropriated without limitation for replacing as well the sum which has been advanced by His Majesty in consequence of the Provincial statute 39. Geo. III Chap. 10, as the sums now resolved to be granted.

Resolved, that it is the opinion of this Committee, that the Lots et Ventes upon any Lands or immoveable property held of His Majesty en roture in this Province, which shall hereafter be collected, be in like manner appropriated without limitation, for replacing as well the sums which have been advanced by His Majesty, in consequence of the aforesaid Provincial Statute 39. Geo. III. Chap. 10. as the sums now resolved to be granted.

RESOLVED, that it is the opinion of this Committee, that for the same purposes the duties imposed on Writs and other Law proceedings in and by the said Provincial Statute 39, Geo. III. Chap. 10, be continued until His Excellency by Proclamation, shall declare that all sums advanced by His Majesty for the erection of Court Houses with proper offices in the Districts of Quebec and Montreal, have been intirely repaid, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the Provincial Parliament. Provided always that the said duties shall not be continued to be levied, when they shall have covered the sum of £4000, one half of the sum of £8000 voted by the Committee, and no more.

On motion of Mr. Lester seconded by Mr. De Bonne,

ORDERED that the question of Concurrence be now put upon each of the Resolutions reported by the Committee.

And the first and second Resolutions of the Committee being again read, and the question separately put thereon, they were severally agreed unto by the House.

The third Resolution being also read,

Mr. Young moved in amendment thereto, seconded by Mr. James Cuthbert,
