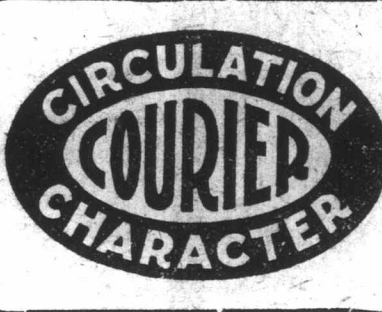

"GOING ON, IF WAR LASTS TEN YEARS."

Spirited Declaration of Rev. Canon Almond, Home From France

Montreal, April 29.—"We are not going to let the Hun hold the land where our dear ones sleep. We are not going to let the Hun trample that pathway our sons and brothers have trod. If the war lasts five or ten years we are going on."

This was the spirited declaration, at the Ypres anniversary celebration yesterday, by Rev. Canon Almond, chaplain, who has recently returned from France.

Canon Almond declared that General Byng had never sent men over the top without going on his knees, while General MacDougall, who commanded the Canadians to-day, had told him after an examination of the lists that not one Canadian had won honors but had come from a Christian home in Canada.

"You cannot leave God out of your life there," he said.

Col. Almond concluded by reciting the prayer of John McCra's famous poem on the graves in Flanders and declared:

"We are not going to break faith with them, please God. We are going on to victory, through our Lord, Jesus Christ."

NAVIGATION OPEN.

Detroit, April 29.—1918 navigation season for through boats opened Sunday when the first boats upbound were reported to have cleared the St. Clair River, which until a few days ago had been blocked with ice. The ice barrier was broken yesterday by four tugs, which returned to this city. More than fifteen upbound freighters departed from here yesterday.

A freighter was reported aground near St. Clair falls, but it is not believed she is in any danger.
