London Presbytery

The Grants for Augmented
Congregations.

Organization of the Presbyterian
Young People's Society.

Waterloo Street Mission to be Organized
as a Regular Church—The Dutton
Call—Various Reports Presented and
Adopted.

The London Presbytery met in Knox Church, St. Thomas, yesterday. Among those present were: Rev. Messrs. Talling, Dr. Sutherland, Currie, Courtney, Johnston, Clarke, Stewart, Wilson, Leith, Brown, Moffat, Scott, Henderson, Sawers, Dewar, McIntyre, Drummond, Ross, Barnett, Milroy, Lawrence, McNeil, Kelso, Johnston and Stuart.

Rev. Mr. Courtney, of Port Stanley, in the absence of the moderator, Rev. Mr. Talling, of London, occupied the chair at the opening.

At the morning session the grants for augmentation were presented and passed as follows: Alymer and Springfield, \$50; Alma Street, St. Thomas, \$50; South Delaware and Tempo, \$15; North Delaware and Caradoc, \$15; Hyde Park and Komoka, \$50; Wardsville and Newbury, \$100; St. Stanley, \$100.

Mr. Courtney presented the report of the Sabbath school committee, and it was received and adopted. It was resolved that the convenor prepare a circular letter, to be read from the pulpits, and sent to Sabbath school superintendents, asking that at least a part of the contributions of the scholars be devoted to the schemes of the church.

As special order of business, Mr. Ross, of Glenora, presented the state of affairs in regard to young people's societies in the Presbytery. There are young people's societies of Christian Endeavor, home mission societies, one society of King's Daughters and Sons, and Bible classes. Mr. Ross read a constitution which might be offered for the organization of these societies in the Presbytery. The report was received, and it was left as business for the afternoon.

AFTERNOON SESSION.
In the afternoon the Presbytery met with the representatives from the young people's societies, and Rev. Mr. Stuart was appointed chairman.

On motion, it was decided to organize, and the societies were enrolled, and the following constitution adopted:

1. Name.—The Presbyterian Young People's Society of the Presbytery of London.

2. Object.—To promote the welfare and the usefulness of the church of the young people of the Presbytery, by uniting them in friendly intercourse, the cultivation of their spiritual life, the study of the doctrines, history and life of the church, and the support of its missionary, educational and benevolent schemes.

3. Membership.—The various young people's societies within the Presbytery, under the oversight of sessions, both society to be represented by its resident and one delegate for every seven members. In congregations where no young people's organization exists, sessions may appoint delegates in the proportion of one to every twenty names on the communion roll.

4. Meetings.—(1) An annual meeting in connection with the May meeting of the Presbytery. (2) Such special meetings as the executive may call; notice of such special meetings to be given to the members.

5. Officers.—The following officers shall be elected: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and four members of the Executive Committee.

6. Finance.—The Executive Committee shall have the right to raise funds for the support of the society, and to expend the same for the same purposes.

7. Reports.—The Executive Committee shall report to the sessions at least once a year, and to the Presbytery at least once a year.

8. Disfranchisement.—Any member who shall be guilty of any act which would bring the society into disrepute, or who shall be guilty of any act which would bring the church into disrepute, shall be disfranchised.

9. Amendments.—The Executive Committee may propose amendments to this constitution, which shall be subject to the approval of the sessions.

10. Dissolution.—In case of dissolution, the assets of the society shall be sold, and the proceeds shall be given to the church.

11. By-Laws.—The Executive Committee may propose by-laws, which shall be subject to the approval of the sessions.

12. Ratification.—This constitution shall be ratified by the sessions of the Presbytery.

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
