## LAMBTON FARMERS WILL TOUR COUNTY

County Seed Association is Arranging Tour, Urging "North" to Visit the "South"

To attain that unity and co-operation which is so essential for the promotion and advancement of the whole county, the Lambton Seed Association is arranging a tour of the County for farmers.

This is part of the plan of the Lambton county corn, grain and seed improvement association, who have introduced a new feature into their work entitled "That we should know our work better." The automobile tour as it has been already planned will begin at Forest and will stop in Sombra on the north banks of the Sydenham river, where a picnic lunch will be held. The reeve of Sombra is requesting all the ratepayers of that township to turn out en masse and welcome the northern visitors. From all appearances to date it promises to be a great event.

At a well attended meeting held in Forest on Tuesday evening by W. P. Macdonald, county agricultural representative, arrangements were made for an automobile trip by the farmers of the north part of the county through the southern townships of the county in order to get better acquainted with each other. The party will leave Forest on Wednesday morning, June 17th, and visit the townships of Sombra, Dawn, and Euphemia. The committee in charge of the arrangements: Mayor Cope, Reeve Hair and Councillor Whyte of Forest; W. J. French, president of the Lambton Corn Growers' Association, and the Reeves of the townships of Bosanquet, Plympton and Warwick. It is expected that over 100 farmers will go on the trip. Later the farmers in the south will visit this north part of the county.
