DEATH OF THE HON. J. J. ROSS, M.D.

The death of the Hon. Dr. Ross, which took place on the 4th of May, removes one who was well known politically and medically. He was a strong Conservative, and once held the position of Premier of the Province of Quebec. At the time of his death he was a member of the Legislative Council of Quebec Province and also of the Senate of the Dominion of Canada. A few years ago he was speaker of the latter. He took a warm interest in all medical matters which came before the Quebec Council, and twice occupied the position of President of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Quebec. His name indicated his Scotch origin, but he was a true French-Canadian. His character included the best of the two races from which he came. His political career was untarnished. No breath of scandal ever touched the name of John I. Ross.
