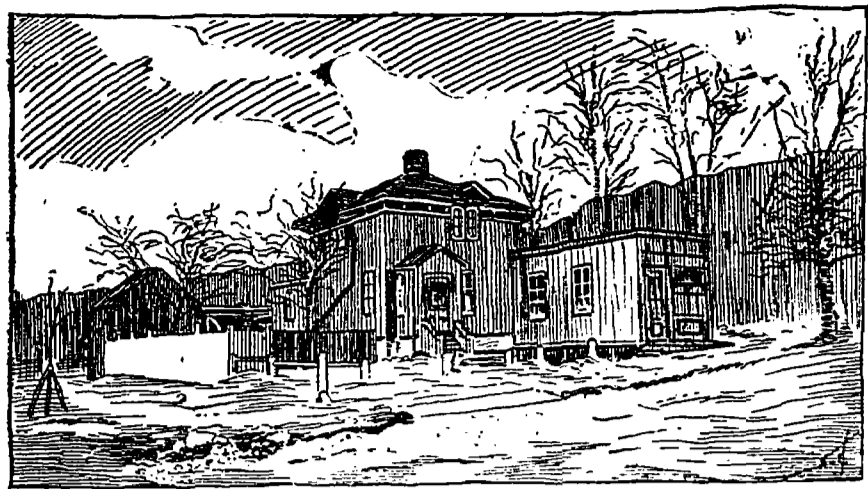


MONTREAL'S VACCINATION INSTITUTE.
