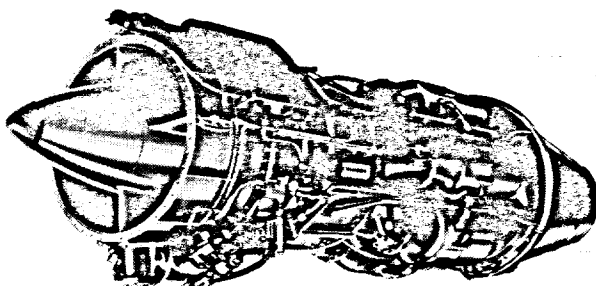
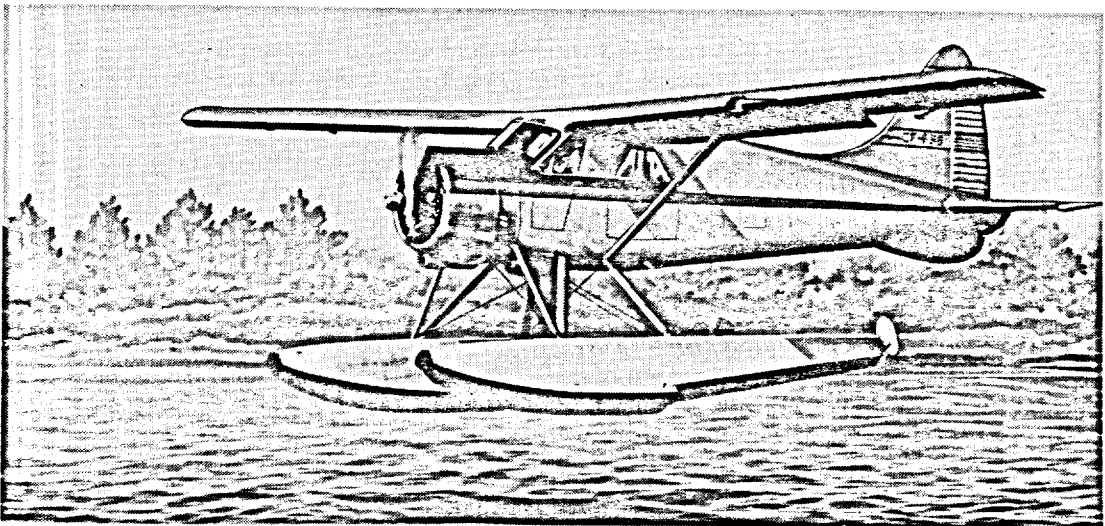


Specially-designed for bulky freight carrying is the Canadian-made Loadmaster, a double-tailed aircraft. It may also carry passengers.
