L.P: But the key to solving these problems lies in what we were discussing at the beginning of this interview: everything depends on what the "Leskhozmash" Association has to offer the forestry enterprise.

L.G.K: That's it, exactly.

## Ordzhonikidze: Source of Sapling Shipments

Specialized forestries in Northern Osetiya are contributing to reforestation projects in various regions of the country. They have just finished shipping planting stock to forestry enterprises, parks, nature reserves and special reserves (<u>zapovedniki</u>) in the Northern Caucasus, the Ukraine, the Volga region and Central Asia. The packages and containers hold more than 30,000 kilogrammes of select walnut, hazel, chestnut, red oak, beech, smooth elm, Alpine pine and birch seeds. This is enough to plant approximately 3,000 hectares of new stands. Specialized operations in the mountainous region of Ordzhonikidze also ship tree and bush saplings to various parts of the country. Most of the seed plots are located in the Ordzhonikidze arboretum plantations.
