• For other goods, tariffs will be eliminated in five equal steps, starting on January 1, 1989, for example:

drugs and cosmetics)

furniture

hardwood plywood most machinery

 All other tariffs will be eliminated in ten equal annual steps, most starting on January 1, 1989, for example:
