DND—PURCHASE OF ENGRAVING MACHINE

Question No. 2,337—Mr. Stewart:

Did the Department of National Defence purchase an engraving machine from Mikon Engineering, Downsview, Ontario at a cost of \$37,017 and, if so, for what purpose and were public tenders called?

Hon. J.-J. Blais (Minister of Supply and Services): The Department of Supply and Services purchased for the Department of National Defence two engraving machines for a total of \$37,017. The machines are intended to (a) replace a condemned item, and; (b) to meet a weapon shop requirement.

Requests for proposal were issued to 29 firms listed on the approved Department of Supply and Services source list.
