Council, and of Committees of the Council, and all Minutes when approved shall be signed by the Presiding Officer, together with the Secretary, of all such meetings of the Association or of the Council.

## THE SEAL

15. The Seal of the Association shall not be affixed to any instrument except by authority of a Resolution of the Council of the Association, or of a Resolution of the members of the Association, as may be prescribed in and by any such Resolution, or (if no officers are prescribed by the Resolution) in the presence of (a) two Councillors of the Association and the Registrar, or (b) the President or Vice-President of the Association and the Registrar and such officers shall sign every instrument to which the Seal of the Association is so affixed in their presence.

## PROCEEDING OF COUNCIL

- 16. The Council of the Association may meet together for the dispatch of business, adjourn, and otherwise regulate their meetings, as it sees fit. Questions arising at any meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes. In case of any equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a timecasting vote—Three Councillors may at any time summon a Meeting of the Council, giving seven days notice to all Members of the date, hour and place of such Meeting.
- 17. The quorum necessary for the transaction of the business of the Council shall be six members.
- 18. It shall be the duty of the President of the Association to preside at all Meetings of the Council, but in his absence then the Vice-President shall preside, or in the absence of both the President and the Vice-President then the Councillors present may choose one of their
