

16. In any case in which articles are under special instructions, procured from a particular tradesman, a similar tender is to be obtained previously to the order being given.

Stores procured under special instructions.

In any case, however, where the Agent shall consider it more to the advantage of the Service to obtain stores otherwise than by tender, he will be at liberty to report the circumstances to the Secretary of State, and request authority for departing from the regulations 15 and 16. It will only be

17. All charges for articles purchased are to be vouched by the requisition or other authority for sending out the supply, and also by bills of particulars and bills of lading, or other sufficient evidence of the actual shipment for the Colony, and by a copy of the letter submitting the requisition to the Secretary of State, and by the authority of the latter any disbursements included in a tradesman's bill, or incurred by you for insurance, duties, and shipping charges, are
