### GRAIN MARKETS STAMPEDE WHEAT CABLES ARE WEAKER

Weak Cables and Disappointment Over Prominent Crop Experts' Figures on Farm Reserves Cause Slump.

World Office Friday Evening, March 5. Liverpool wheat futures to-day closed 1d lower than yesterday, and corn closed 3d higher. Chicago May wheat closed 3c lower than yesterday, corn closed 3/4c lower, and oats 3/4c lower. Shipping car lots of wheat to-day, 233, against 133 this day last year. Chicago car lots of wheat, 82; contract, 24. Corn, 33; contract, 15. Oats, 20; contract, 42. Northwest car lots, 259, against 243 last year. Preliminary: Wheat, 429,000 bushels; last week, 385,000; last year, 422,000. Shipments, 27,900; last week, 28,000; last year, 28,000. Corn, 67,000; last week, 66,000; last year, 62,000. Shipments, 576,000; last week, 378,000; last year, 377,000. Oats, 575,000; shipments, 447,000.
