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The Queen and the Royal Family.

Her Majesty, Victoria by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, Empress of India (in India Kaiser-i-Hind), born May 24th, 1819; succeeded to the Throne June 20, 1837, on the death of her uncle, King William IV., crowned June 28, 1838, and married February 10, 1840, to his late Royal Highness, Francis Albert Augustus Charles Emanuel, Prince Consort, Duke of Saxony, Prince of Cobourg and Gotha. Her Majesty is the only child of his late Royal Highness Edward, Duke of Kent, son of King George III. The children of Her Majesty are:

Her Imperial Majesty Victoria Adelaide Mary Louise, Princess Royal, Empress Frederick of Germany, born November 21, 1840 and married to the late Emperor Frederick of Germany, January 25, 1858, and has issued four sons and four daughters.

His Royal Highness Albert Edward,

Prince of Wales, born November 9, 1841, married March 10, 1863, Alexandra of Denmark (Princess of Wales), born December 1, 1844, and has issue Albert Victor, Duke of Clarence and Avondale, born January 8, 1864, died January 14, 1892; George Frederick Ernest Albert, Duke of York, born June 3, 1865, married Princess May of Teck, July 6, 1893, and has issue a son, Edward A. C. G. A. P. D., born June 23, 1894; Louise Victoria Alexandra Dagmar, born February 20, 1867, married Duke of Fife July 27, 1889; Victoria Alexandra Olga Mary, born July 6, 1898; Maude Charlotte Mary Victoria, born November 26, 1899.

Her Royal Highness Alice Maud Mary, born April 25, 1843; married to H. R. H. Prince Frederick Louis of Hesse, July 1, 1862; died December 14, 1878, and had issue five daughter and two sons; second son killed by accident May, 1873.

His Royal Highness Alfred Ernest Albert, Duke of Edinburgh, born August 6, 1844; married her Imperial Highness the Grand

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
