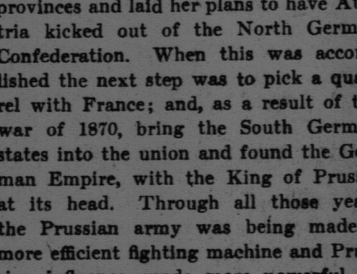
CONCERNING MR. SMITH.
