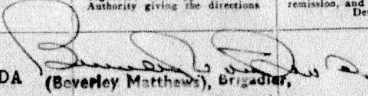
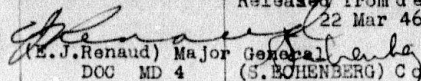


VI.—Action on Review.

(Whether the sentence or sentences are suspended or in execution).

Any Reviewing Authority under Section 57 of the Army Act may under that Section mitigate, remit or commute a sentence which is in execution, and if the sentence as commuted or mitigated is penal servitude, imprisonment or detention, it will remain subject to the powers granted by Section 57A of the Army Act. A partial remission of a sentence in suspension is not legal.

When on active service, committing a civ offence, that is to say, stealing in that he in BRUSSELS on or about 5 Dec 1944 at 338 Avenue de JETTE, BRUSSELS, stole a watch and chain and monies in the amount of 1100 Belgian frs, the property of Mr. Jean Louis MONNOL.

THIRD CHARGE SEC 15(1) ARMY ACT

When on active service, absenting himself without leave in that he at the 13 Bn, 2 CERG, absented himself without leave from 1000 hrs 24 Oct 1944 until apprehended in BRUSSELS at 1130 hrs on 11 Dec 1944.
Total time of absence 48 days, 1 hr, 35 mins.

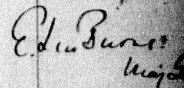
