

W^o Brighton, The Hill, the accused was lodged in the City Police Jail for the night and escorted the following morning March 11/40 to Weyburn by The Macaulay F.A.; On C.P.R. train leaving Moose Jaw 0750 hrs and arrived Weyburn 1040 hrs. The accused did not buy his own ticket for return. After his ^(accused) arrest on night of March 10/40 I ^{ADMM} telephoned Capt. Mathers, advising him that I had the accused under arrest. Capt. Mathers arranged about transportation, and I picked the ticket up in the morning at the ticket office.

On March 4/40 The Hill, the accused, was on pack drill from 1800 to 1900 hrs. and was missing from defaulters call at 2000 hrs. It was reported to
