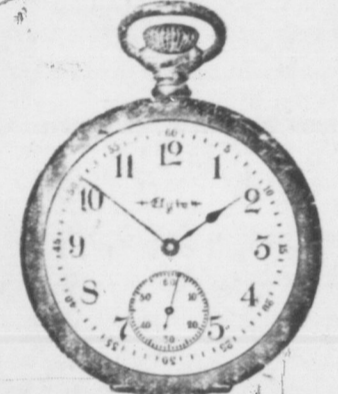

"Why, let me see, how old are you?" said Mr. Deane, as he threw himself backward again. "Sixteen—I mean, I am going in seventeen," said Tom, hoping his uncle noticed how much beard he had. "Let me see—your father had some notion of making you an engineer, I think?" "But I don't, think I could get any money at that for a long while, could I?" "That's true; but people don't get much money at anything, my boy, when they're only sixteen. You've had a good deal of schooling, however; I suppose you're pretty well up in accounts, eh? You understand book-keeping?" "No," said Tom rather falteringly. "I was in practice. But Mr. Stelling says I write a good hand, uncle. That's my writing," added Tom, laying on the table a copy of the list he had made yesterday. "Ah! that's good, that's good.
