

# Mount Robson and Tumbling Glacier



From Mount Robson Station on the Canadian Northern Transcontinental Line in British Columbia, it is four and one-half miles, as the crow files, to the precipitous base of Mount Robson. Berg Lake, the ideal camp site, and where the best view of the mountain and other snow-clad peaks is to be had, is fourteen miles beyond. The trail in, through "The Valley of a Thousand Falls," and passing "White" and "Emperor Falls" en route, constitutes a delightful avenue of approach to one of the greatest of the natural show-pieces in the world of mountains. Anyone in a great hurry might make the trip and be on the C.N.R. line again in two days.

If an architect should be called upon to describe Mount Robson, he would probably commence by terming this peak "the gable line of natural construction in Canada." And he would be justified, as its new-crown is at an altitude of 13,065 feet above the sea. Berg Lake, shown at its base, is 5,566 feet above the Pacific. As viewed from the Lake, Robson rises almost sheer. Tumbling glacier (in the centre) a living stream of ice almost two miles long, drops from the shoulder of Robson to the glacial waters, of Berg Lake. To the right, and barely discernible in the photograph, is Mist glacier. To the left, but not shown in this illustration, is the Main glacier, largest and most accessible of those known in Canada, which leads from the back of the camp site on the lake, up among the surrounding mountains, making easy the ascent of peaks such as Mount Resplendent, which is 11,173 feet in height.
