"Bast of Rheims the fighting was likewise ended to the advantage of the French. The Germans, having been successful in penetrating the woods northeast of Sillery, were driven out by a counter-attack."

"Prisoners taken in the region of Rheims declared that the town was attacked by three divisions, which were ordered to take the place at all costs during the night."

The front of the new German attack is the semi-circle drawn by the enemy about the city of Rheims in the recent offensive on the Aisne front. The Rheims region comprised the left flank of the Cerman attack. Ground was given by the French on both sides of the cathedral city, but the town itself and the nearby protecting forts were held against the German ouslaught and have since remained in French possession.

Rheims, however, was hemmed in on three sides by the enemy, and it has been considered only a question of time when the Germans would make a concerted movement to out its defenders. The front line of the present attack, from Vrigny, west of the city, to La Pompelle, around the semi-circle to the east, is approximately fourteen miles.

London, June 19—British troops last night successfully raided the German lines in the region to the south of Hebuterns, north of Albert.
