

Ottawa, Feb 3.—The department of the navai service has established on the east coast of Canada four direc-tion-finding stations, which will, it is expected, prove of great value to ves-sels lost in the fog and unable to de termine their position. These sta-tions are located at Cape Sable, the mouth of Halitax harbor, Cape Canso and Cape Race, Newfoundiand. From any or all of these stations a vessel with wireless may obtain a hearing while at a distance of several hundred miles from tha coast. 


