CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

There has been a fair degree of activity in the lumber market during the past week. Some dissatisfaction is expressed in regard to United States shipments, but business locally compares very favorably with one year ago. Some dealers report that their facilities are taxed to the utmost to fill the large number of small orders which call for immediate delivery, which is an indication that consumers and retail dealers are carrying very light stocks. There is a very fair demand for bill stuff and some difficulty has been experienced in obtaining the necessary material to fill orders. The pine market as a whole is exhibiting strength, and any change in prices is likely to be in the direction of an improvement.

Buyers who have visited the hardwood mills have found that there is not a large quantity of stock offering nor any weakness in prices. Manufacturers seem to have become satisfied that the entire hardwood production will find a market at the prices now prevailing, and accordingly no concessions of consequence are being made. Hardwoods for interior finish are in good demand in Toronto. The furniture and implement factories are also willing buyers of stock. Lath and shingles are moving in some volume at unchanged prices. The consumption of No. 1 pine lath in Toronto is considerable, but there is very little demand for No. 2 excepting in the country districts.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Considerable lumber is changing hands in the Eastern Provinces, notwithstanding the low prices, but it is composed chiefly of small lots, as buyers are not disposed to assume much risk until conditions improve. British deals are fully \$2 per thousand lower than one year ago, which leaves little or no profit for the producer.
