GENERAL ORDERS for the MILITIA of the Province of QUEBEC:

Head Quarters, Quebec, 22d. July, 1790.



S the general Protection of His Majesty's Dominions in America, in Case of a War with Spain, may require the Regular Forces in this Province to be withdrawn, and Canada, for a Time, be left to her own Defence, common Prudence demands, that all necessary Measures be taken to meet that Event.

THE Strength and Exertions of the Inhabitants are the Natural Protection of every Country, and when properly arranged as Militia cannot fail to become its chief and most permanent Support.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR therefore recommends to the different Commandants and Officers of the Militia to take all fuitable Opportunities of imprefing the Minds of the People with the Necessity of Self Defence, as an indifpentible Duty, intimately connected with the prefervation of their Lives and Property.

THEY will also confider of the proper Means for putting the Militia under their Command in the most respectable Condition, that they may not only be able to defend themselves and the Province against all defultory or piratical Attacks, in the Absence of the Regular Troops, but also, should the Safety of the Country render it necessary, that Competent Detachments from their Numbers may be prepared to join, and act with, the Regular Forces. For this Purpole it may be advileable to collect for a limited Time from every Comparty a proportion of the young Men, that they may be the more eafily trained up and exercised in the Use of Arms, and be more ready to protect their Fellow Citizens from Infult and Interruption in their peaceful Occupations. The Colonels and Field Officers of the feveral Diffricts or Divisions of the Militia are therefore requested to confult together, as far as Convenience may permit, and digeft the proper Arrangements for carrying this Measure into Execution, whenever it shall be found expedient, transmitting the Refult of their Deliberations feveraly from each Diffrict to the Adjutant General for His Excellency's Information.

THESE Detachments, when collected and embodied to ferve for a limited Time not exceeding Two Years, will for their greater Eafe and Encouragement receive Pay, Provisions, Arms, and Quarters, in the fame Manner as His Majefty's marching Regiments in this Province, with Cloathing of equal Value, or a Compensation in lieu thereof.

THE Commandants of the several Battalions of Militia west of Point an Baudet, are to transmit the Reports for their respective Districts to Star JOHN JOHNSON Baronet, who will forward the same to Head Quarters.
