Praises Drum Corp

BRAMPTON — "A more satisfying experience cannot be found than to work yourself to exhaustion with a drum corps in competition and then stand waiting for your score, and hear in first place and the New York Drum Corps Association Junior 'A' champions for 1966, the K. of C. St. John's Girls' Drum Corps of Brantford, Ont.

Paul Ransom, public relations director of the recently-formed Brampton Senators Drum and Bugle Corps made this comment:

Mr. Ransom had suggested to one of the Senators it would be nice to see a drum corps in action. He and Peter Ringler, Streetsville, were kept on the move for 69 hours, averaged six hours sleep, drove about 850 miles to do it. Their object of the weekend was to follow in the wake of the St. John's Girls' Drum Corps of Brantford. The corps was formerly known as the St. John's College Girls' Corps, but only boys now attend the college with the girls being allowed the equipment and practice room.

The two left Brampton on Friday, drove to Port Dover, watched a long parade in hot weather, with the drum corps participating. A field show followed with various corps performing in exhibition. The Brantford group were favorites.

Following a midnight return to Brantford, a trip was made to Hespeler the next day for a longer, hotter parade, with another return to Brantford.

An early start was made Sunday morning with a special mass in St. John's College Chapel before leaving for Rochester, N. Y. at 7:30 a.m. The group arrived in Rochester at 12:30 noon, and a practice was held before the show. The temperature during the show was 112 degrees and a number of the girls were overcome with the heat.

This was the first year a special girls' trophy was awarded, as previously the girls had to compete against the boys. Awards won previously were Canadian Drum Corps National Junior "A" Champions, in 1962, '63, '64, '65 and Ontario Junior "A" Champions in 1963, '64, '65. Climax of effort, practice and time was being named New York - Canadian Junior "A" Champions.

Mr. Ransom and Peter Ringler attended the competition at Brantford July 9 and feel the attendance during the two weekends is only a foretaste of the future way of life for members of the Senators.

The Brantford group is familiar to residents having competed in the Brampton Flower Festival for the past two years.
