I have the honour to report having visited the Indians of Manouan Port in the Province of Quebec. On the 17th instant I held council with them and on the 18th visited their holdings.

By appointment I was met at the port by Father Gueguen of Maniwaki who ministers to the Indians of those parts. All of the Manouan Indians are Roman Catholics but they have no resident missionary. Nor have they a school.

As the Department is aware these Indians are Têtes des Boules. They are part of the St Maurice Band. As an impression once apparently prevailed that they were connected with the River Deserch Indians I made particular enquiry upon this
