Pilot became lost and aircraft crashed while executing precautionary landing with under-carriage retracted. Pilot was dangerously injured, and died in Madison Barracks Hospital, New York, June 5th.

	4-6-42		Cloudy with showers. The Commanding Officer's Weekly Parade was held at 0745 hours.
