

Wm Smith's Record

*Copy of Diary of Farmer Joseph
H. Smith for Month ending 31st January
1895.*

*1st Clear and Cold. I spent the
day at home with my family. The
majority of the Indians with their families
called on me.*

*2nd Clear windy and very cold. I visited
every House and Hable on Reserve and
examined the Potatoes in Cellars. Indians
were hauling wood to House and Hay
to Hables.*

*3rd Clear and Cold. I visited some
of the Indian House and Hables and
also examined all water holes and
saw some of the Cattle watered. Indians
were taking wheat to the mill to be milled
and hauling Hay to Hables.*

*4th Clear and Cold. The same work
was performed as on 3rd.*

*5th Cloudy and pleasant with snow
during the evening. I was cutting wood
for the use of my own House; I am obliged
to do a lot of work of this kind as the
Indians of this Reserve will not do any
work for their Farm without receiving
high Cash wages. Indians were hauling
Hay to Hables.*

6th Cloudy with snow. No.
