

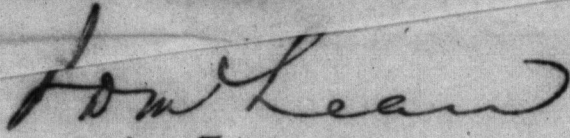
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Ottawa, February 29, 1908.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant, inclosing copy of resolution passed by the Rama Council, recommending that a permit be issued to Jonathan York to cut and dispose of timber on one acre and a half of land which he is clearing for cultivation, and in reply to say that you may issue a permit to him on the usual conditions, and if he cannot clear the land out over he will be expected to have the work done for him, which you should see is properly completed.
