You should also inform the Directors of the Company that the C. P. Railway Co. in addition to passing through the Nisley-old River, is shown on the plans in this Department, to pass through the following Indian reserves:-

The Salmon River Indian Reserve No. 1, situated at the west end of the Salmon River Great Shuswap Lake.

Salmon River Indian Reserve No. 2, also situated on the Salmon River, at the mouth of Salmon River.
