
Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 7th April last, No. 82/27, I beg to inform you that the Department of the Interior has consented to reserve from sale and settlement Township 28, Range 1, W. I. M., and the timber thereon from license, until this Department is able to have the survey made of the land desired as an addition to the Red River Indian reserve. If Mr. Reid completes his work in the Carlton Agency to allow sufficient time to make this survey, he will probably be instructed to confer with you, with the view of doing the work this fall.
