



OTTAWA, July 12th., 1916.

Sir,-

I beg to inform you that the Department has written to Dr. Robertson, at Howick Mills, and Dr. Hallin, at St. Mary's Ferry, drawing attention to the fact that they have not of late been sending in their reports of medical work done. Reports are required from Dr. Robertson for April, May and June, and from Dr. Hallin for May and June. Each of the doctor has been told to send his reports to you for transmission to the Department. As soon as you receive them you should transmit them to Head-quarters. I may remind you that it is your duty to see that these reports reach the Department regularly. It is proposed to hold the salary cheques of the doctors mentioned until the reports asked for are received.
