Sir,-

I beg to advise you that Miss McGrand, teacher of the Tobique Indian School, has been informed that the classes in domestic science may be continued this year in the school on the same conditions as other years, i.e. that she will be paid \$3.00 for each meeting, not to exceed \$12.00 a month, this to include the services of an assistant. You will be good enough to advise the Department as to the name of the assistant employed. The teacher has been instructed to furnish monthly reports on the work, which should be forwarded to the Department through your office. These classes may commence in November and be continued during the winter months, or until April 30th, next.

You may furnish Miss McGrand with the usual quantity of material for these lessons.
