



Dear Sir,-

Referring to previous correspondence regarding the purchase of a Fordson tractor, I found that I could not obtain one through the Provincial Government, as we did in several other instances, and, further, that the price had been increased from \$750.00 to \$950.00. In view of this and the comparative lateness of the season, I doubt the wisdom of purchasing for the Tyendinaga agency this fall. I am also informed that Mr. Haracle has purchased one on his own account, this being so, I would like to know by return mail if arrangements could not be made with him whereby other Indians might obtain the use of his tractor on terms to be arranged.
