Ottawa, June 19, 1919.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant, in which you inform the Department that you have been appointed secretary treasurer of the Separate School, Section No. 5, Bagot Township, in place of James L. Legree who has resigned.

In reply I beg to say that all cheques for grant due for the tuition of Indian children at this school will, in future, be made payable and sent to you. A supply of blank quarterly report forms are being sent under separate cover. No returns showing the attendance of Indian children have been received for the quarter ending March 31st, last. You will be good enough to have the teacher prepare a return for that quarter and also a return at the end of the present quarter and forward them to the Department in order that the amount due can be paid.

I enclose herewith a statement showing all monies paid your predecessor for the tuition of Indian children also the dates such payments were made and the amount of each.
