"L/Sgt. Carr, whom I now recognize, was working for
me at "A" Bty No 2 C.A.R.U. At 1200 hours on 17 Apr 44
L/Sgt. Carr was due to return from pass. At 1300 hours
17 Apr 44 he, L/Sgt. Carr, did not appear on parade and
as I was not able to have him located in Camp I had him
reported as absent without leave from 1200 hrs 17 Apr 44."

on my A.W.L. list from 1200 hours 17 Apr 44, which I
did. He was kept on my A.W.L. list until he reported
back to me at 2345 hours 4 May 44, at "A" Bty Orderly
Room, No 2 C.A.R.U."
