I enclose herewith copy of a letter dated the 7th of May, 1942, which was forwarded by Mr. Indian Agent Sampson at Telegraph Creek to the Divisional Registrar in respect to transfer of employment of Indians in his Agency from one occupation to another. These Indians are trappers who are engaged during the present time in war activities in connection with the construction of airports and the Alaska Highway. During the summer months, it appears to me that there is no way in which your regulations can be made applicable to these people unless you wish to station an officer in this remote locality. However, I should appreciate your advice in the matter in order that I may inform Mr. Sampson as requested by him.
