The newly elected President, the Hon. D. McN. Parker, M. D., then took the Chair, and read the rules of order.

The President read a letter from G. H. Dobson, Esq., enclosing a P. O. order for \$100 for Foreign Missions, from the North Sydney (C. B.) Baptist Church.

The Committee on Arrangements further reported, recommending that the Rev. Jay S. Backus, D. D., preach the Convention Sermon, instead of the Rev. J. E. Goucher, who had asked to be relieved.

That the hour preceding the morning session of the Convention be allotted for Committees, or for the Board of Governors of Acadia College.

That the Rev. W. S. McKenzie, A. M., preach the Convention Sermon at the next annual session, and that the Rev. J. E. Hopper, A. M., be his alternate.
