ON the recommendation of the Honorable the Minister of Customs, and under the provisions of the 9th and 53th sections of the Act passed in the Session of the Parliament of Canada, held in the 40th year of Her Majesty's reign, chapter 10, and entitled: "An Act to amend and consolidate the Acts respecting the Customs," His Honor, by and with the advice of the Queen's Privy Council of Canada, has been pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, that Kenville, in the Province of Nova Scotia, be and is hereby constituted and appointed to be an Out Port of Entry of Customs and a Warehousing Port; also that the said Out Port of Kenville be and it is hereby placed under the survey of the Collector of Customs at the Port of Cornwallis, in the said Province of Nova Scotia.
