Besides being recognized as one of the most stately architectural piles on the Continent of North America, these buildings house the best public library west of Winnipeg; Natural History Museum, containing specimens of all the fauna of British Columbia; mineral exhibits and archives. In these latter will be found relics of the aboriginal life of this province, which is so quickly passing away, and also many of the original logs and charts of the Discoverers not only of Vancouver Island, but of the whole Pacific Coast.
