An ACT in addition to and in amendment of an Act intituled "An Act for "the REGULATION of SEAMEN." Passed the 9th Day of February, 1798.

Presmble

THEERAS, in and by the third section of an act made and passed in the twenty fixth year of His Majesty's reign intituled " An Act for the Regulation of Seamen" it is enacted "that if the master or commander of any ship or vessel " shall ship any Seaman, knowing him to be first entered and " shipped on board of any other ship or vessel, or after notice "thereof given him, shall not forthwith dismis him, every " fuch master or commander so offending and being thereof "convicted shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten pounds to the "use of the city or county where such offence shall be commit-"ted, to be fued for in any Court of Record proper to try the same; " and fuch Seaman fo shipping himself, being under the obli-"gation of a former contract, shall forfeit and pay the value of one month's wages that he shall in agree for, to be deducted .. 😘 from
