A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Province stands prorogued to the

cent public calamity, and other weighty reasons, an early meeting of the Legislature
is found expedient; I do therefore, by the advice of Her Majesty's Executive Council,
further prorogue the said General Assembly, until Tuesday the tenth day of Septem-
ber next, then to meet at Fredericton, for the dispatch of business.
