

That a committee be appointed to examine and report such Laws as have expired or are near expiring.

That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor requesting him to direct that there be laid before the House a state of the funds already appropriated for an *Academical Establishment* in this province and such other information on the subject as His Excellency may think proper—

And requested leave to sit again.

Ordered, that the said report be accepted;

That Mr. *William Pagan*, Mr. *Kinnear*, Captain *Clinch*, Major *Murray* and Mr. *Colin Campbell*, be a committee to prepare a bill “*For laying an Impost*.” Committee appointed.

That Mr. *Chipman*, Mr. *Glenie* and Mr. *Hardy*, be a committee to examine and report such Laws as have expired, or are near expiring :

And that Major *Coffin*, Major *Hailes* and Mr. *Robert Pagan* be a committee to prepare the said Address to His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor.

On motion made and seconded—

Ordered, that a committee be appointed to bring in a bill “*For the better Regulating the Formation of Juries*.” Committee appointed.

Mr. *Glenie*, Mr. *Chipman*, Mr. *Hardy*, Major *Coffin* and Mr. *Robert Pagan*, are appointed for that purpose.

Read, the first time—

A bill in amendment of an Act intituled “*An Act for more effectually Securing the Title of Purchasers of Real Estates against Claims of Dower*”—and for other purposes therein mentioned. Bill read.

The further consideration of His Excellency's speech is postponed until to-morrow. Consideration of H. E. speech postponed.

The House adjourned until eleven o'clock to-morrow morning. House adjourn'd.
