A HAMILTON SUICIDE.

James Hodge Shot Himself in the City Hall.

HE ONCE BELONGED TO NEWMARKET

Had Considerable Money a Few Years Ago. Was Well Through at All and Had a Good Deal of Late Apparent Quite Cheerful Before Firing the Shot.

Hamilton, Jan. 10.—(Special.)—One of the most sensational suicides that have occurred in this part of the country for some time took place in the city last night. About 8:30 James Hodge, 68 years of age, strong and heavily built, walked into the City Hall and after looking around for a few minutes, seated himself at the foot of the staircase leading to the council chamber and, pulling a revolver from his pocket, he fired a bullet through his brain.

The spot where the man ended his life is not more than 20 feet from the office of the chief of police and the detective headquarters, and Chief Smith and Detective Inspector McMahon, being in their office, happened to learn the cause of the loud report.

In a reclining position on the stairway Hodge was the sturdy form of Hodge who a few minutes before had Mr. Huron, the wife of the cashier of the City Hall, good evening, apparently in good spirits. He held the revolver in his right hand, and in the right side of his head, just over the eye, a wound about the size of a bullet had entered. In his pocket was a note stating that he had been working for some time as a clerk in New York.

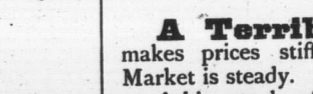
