

MOTOR CAR EXPORTS

Three months ago when the General Motors Corporation policy of correentrating export business at its Oshawa plant was announced it did not seem that this development would be of much importance to Canadian industry for some time to come. Export business in every line was at its lowest ebb. In the very short space of time that has elapsed much has happened; the Washington Disarmament Conference in particular has succeeded in injecting a note of confidence into internatioal trade; the possibilities of a solution of international currency problems, suggested by the study being given by men of finance to questions of exchange and foreign credits, is another factor that is making exporters and imoprters more

hopeful of the outlook. Now an average of one hundred automobiles a day are being shipped by the General Motors Oshawa Plant to all parts of the world. This is in addition to the Domestic business of the McLaughlin, Chevrolet and Oldsmobile units. The total is rapidly mounting and it is quite possible that shortly the export business o the cor-

poration will exceed the total daily mestic production in Canada before

this most recent development.

The cars shipped include Buicks Chevrolets and Oldsmobiles while the Oakland, another General Motors Corporation car that has never been manifactured in Canada will be added to the list shortly. All of those cars are manufactured in Oshawa. The countries they are shipped to include practically every nation on the map. In a recent visit to the plant the writer passed through the Shipping Room and one trainload that was being made had cars packed for Baranquilla, Canary Islands, London, Eng., Sydney, Christiana, Ragoon, Barcelona, Hong Kong and Buenos Ayres. The cars shipped to Engliand are consigned direct to a subsidary company in the British Isles but the automobiles for the other points are shipped to local dealers and agencies who have established credits with the General Motors Export Company.

The requirements of the nations to which the cars are shipped are always kept in view. For the English market the cars are all right hand drives, have grey rather than black or blue bodies, cloth tops and the batteries are on the running board. The first s an essential in the British market; the last three features are a recognization of the value of observing the mall points that bring favor.

y the General Motors Canadian inrests at Oshawa about two years ago now proving its usefuiness in the handling of the new business. There is room under one roof for forty-eight freight cars which are loaded with the most scientific precision. The packing of the individual cars is the result of deep study of the subject. The General Motors shops in Oshawa are running to almost full capacity. About 1800 employees are at present on the pay roll. In Walkerville, Ontario where the heavy parts for General Motors cars are made the factories employ about 750 at present. This staff is engaged in the manufacturing of motors, Axles, Transmissions and other heavy parts of McLaughlins, Buicks, Oldsmobiles and Chevrolets which are assembled and finished in the Oshawa factories. To Canadian business men there i

a deep interest in the fact that such a large export business has been built up in Canada practically overnight. In many ways the manufacture of these cars in Canada and their ex port from Canada will help to solve some of Oshawa, the employment of more men at the plant, and the creation of new business for tanneries fcundries, lumber millsl, tire companies, etc. are impartant considerations but they are not the only ones. The creation of new traffic for the county's underfed railway lines and the building up of a favorable trade balance to offset our already none too satisfactory balance abroad are two benefits that will accrue to Canada from this new development that must be met with general satisfaction. The fact that the shipments are being made as far as possible in Canadian boats is also worthy of attention.
